Improve degraded remnant vegetation

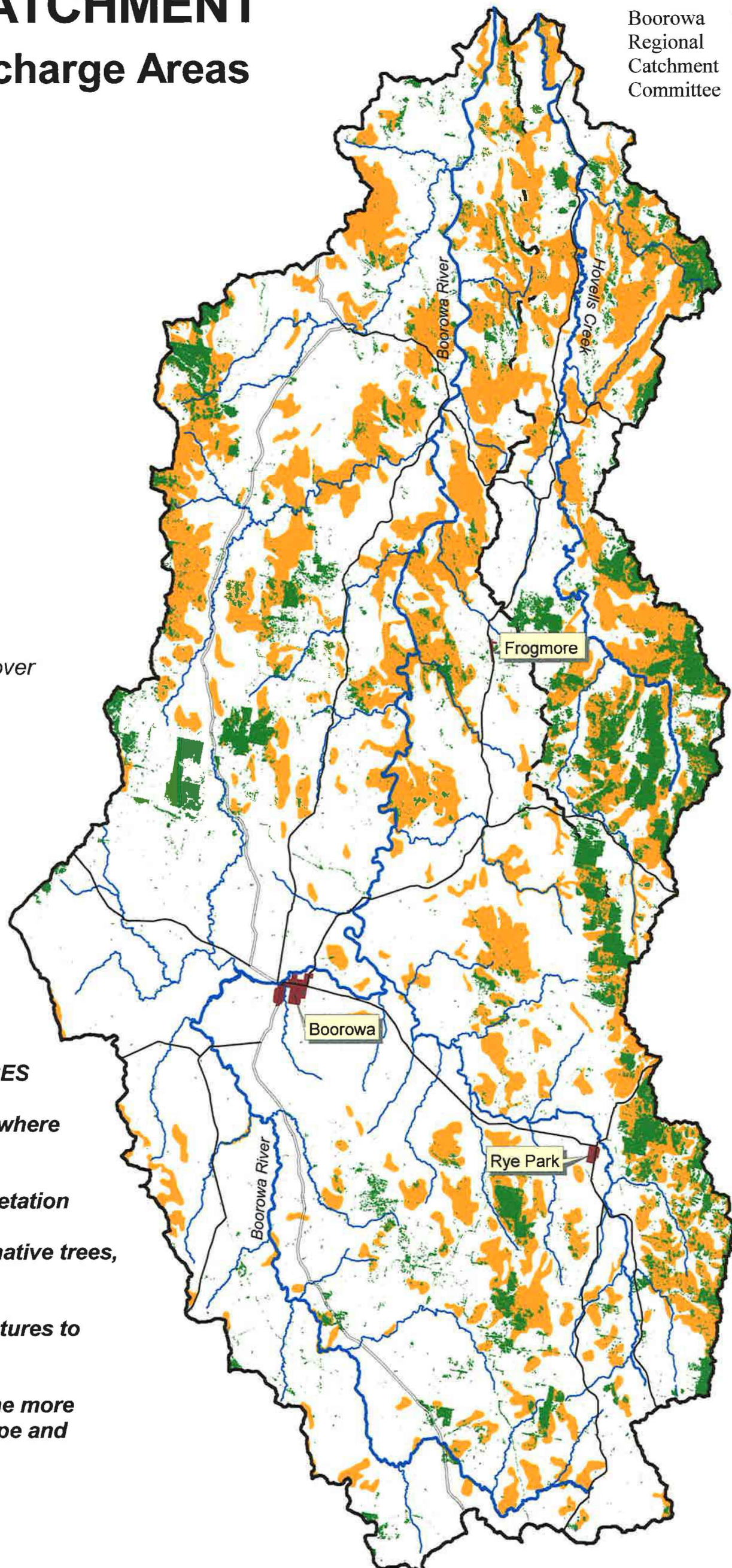
Revegetate cleared areas with native trees, shrubs and grasses

Fence areas to separate from the more productive parts of the landscape and protect from stock
